Title: Deer Valley Board Remuneration Policy

Effective: June 7, 2024

Purpose:

The Municipalities Regulations (section 22.2(1)(g)) requires a hamlet board to establish a policy respecting board remuneration.

Definitions:

"Board" means the board of the Organized Hamlet of Deer Valley

"Hamlet" means the Organized Hamlet of Deer Valley

"Indemnity" means remuneration

"Municipality" means the council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189

Policy Statement:

As per section 72 of *The Municipalities Act*, a hamlet board may request the Municipality to pay an indemnity (remuneration) to members of the hamlet board for services provided during the board's term of office.

Remuneration rates are to be reviewed annually by the board and then recommended to the Municipality for consideration/approval. Remuneration must form part of the hamlet's annual operating budget.

Rates to be considered:

- Mileage rate;
- Meeting rate; and
- Hourly rate (to compensate for replying to emails, investigating resident concerns, meeting preparation, etc.

As per the hamlet's Public Notice Policy, the board, at its discretion, may consult hamlet residents when contemplating an amendment to the Remuneration Policy.
